The Board entered into a contract with
the City of Lawrence Kansas, for the use of rooms
for County officers, in the market house of said City,
"situate on N.W. Cor. of 17th and Henry St." for a
term of (5) five years from Jan'y 1st A.D. 1891.
at an annual rental of \$1,700⁰⁰ payable quarterly
Jan'y, Apr, July, and Oct. of each year in the sum of
\$425⁰⁰, each quarter.

The following rooms are included
in said Contract.

To wit. All the rooms in East Wing
first floor of said building except the room in the South-
west Cor., occupied by Police Judge.

Also, all rooms on
second floor of said building, except the room in the
north east cor. thereof now being used for the Council
Chamber and office of the City Clerk.
