On the 7th day of April A.D. 1891, a Road Petition signed by Wm^o Meybriugh and others was filed and this day presented to the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County Kansas, praying for the "Vacation" of a certain road in said county as follows, to wit: Beginning at the S.E. Cor of the N.E. 1/4 of Sec 15, T. 14, R. 16. Thence North on section line 100 rods. Thence N.E. through N.E. 1/4 of Sec 14, Thence through S.E. Cor of S.W. 1/4 of Sec 11, to intersect road running down Washington Creek. Said petition was accompanied with a bond as required by law signed by Wm^o Meybriugh as principal and S.W. Metaker as surety, in the sum of all costs and expenses accruing on view. Whereupon said bond was approved by the Board, and it appearing to the satisfaction of the Board that the law had been substantially complied with, it was "Ordered" by the Board that Sam^l Fisher, Sam^l Metaker and J. Hoover be appointed viewers on the vacation of said road, and that they meet in conjunction with the County surveyor at the place of beginning, on the day designated in their notice and proceed to view said road, according to law giving to all parties a hearing and make due report of their proceedings to the County Board.
