Presented to the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County Kansas. Praying for the "Location" of a certain road described as follows: to wit
Beginning at the corner to Sec^s 9, 10, 15 & 16, Town 18, Range 20, in center of County road No. 80.
Thence North on, or near, Sec. line between Sec^s 9 & 10 & 13, R. 20, about 78. miles to intersect No. 57.

Said petition was accompanied with a bond as required by law signed by J. O. Chambers as principal, J. W. Fenn and C. H. Nagle as sureties in the sum of all costs and expenses accruing on said view.

Whereupon said bond was approved by the Board, and in appearing to the satisfaction of the Board that the law had been substantially complied with, it was "Ordered" that O. P. Kennedy, W. L. Tuttle and J. D. Theadore be appointed viewers on the proposed road and that they meet in conjunction with the County Surveyor at the place of beginning on the day designated in their notice and proceed to view and lay out said road according to law giving to all parties a hearing and make due report of their proceedings to the County Board.

On the 6th day of March A.D. 1891, a Road Petition signed by D. D. Doye and 80 others was filed and this day presented to the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County Kansas. Praying for the "Location" of a certain road described as follows: to wit:

Beginning 16 Rods N of & E. Cor of N 1/2 & E 1/2 of Sec 34, T 14, R 20, where old Lawrence road intersects section line between Sec^s 27 & 34. Thence to run S. 78. down the ridge to the crossing of Tenth & Main St^s in the old Pulmyra town site. Thence S to Seventh St. Thence commence at the crossing of Tenth & Main St^s and run East 80 rods to intersect the west end of the bottom Coal Creek road.

Said petition was accompanied with a bond as required by law, signed by D. D. Doye as principal, L. A. Coverts, W. D. Martin, Jos Pittman & others as sureties, in the sum of all expenses and costs accruing on view.
