

Lawrence Kansas April 15th A.D. 1891.

The Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County Kansas,
met at the office of the County Clerk

All of the members ^{present} and the County Clerk being present.
Bridge Petition.

The Board gave a hearing to Mr Chas Lotzholtz
Mayor of Eudora City. W. Hill and others interested over
petition signed by over 200. citizens of Douglas County
asking for an appropriation of \$2,000.00 in conjunction
with \$2,000.00 from Eudora City, \$2,000.00 from Eudora Township,
\$2,000.00 from Leavenworth County and \$2,000.00 from Reno Township
Leavenworth County. for the purpose of building a free wagon
bridge across Kansas River at or near the North line
of Eudora City.

Mr Lotzholtz also stated that on the 14th
day of April 91. he was in consultation with the Honorable
Board of County Commissioners of Leavenworth County Kans.
That said Board expressed a desire to meet with the
Hon. Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County Kans
with the civil engineers of both County's, at the place
where said bridge is desired located, for the purpose
of investigating as to the feasibility and necessity for
building said bridge.

The Board having the aforesaid
matter under consideration

It was "Ordered" that Monday
June 15th 1891. be fixed as date for such consultation.

The Board examined Tax petitions, and without action
on same.
