the Rayson Bridge across Little Wakarusa Creek Endora
Twp. on Frid^y May 15th, and the Lem Bryan Bridge across
Mud Creek Wakarusa Twp. and bridge across Corn
Creek LeCompton Twp. on Sat^d May 16th. and this day
accept same as being constructed according to
plans and specifications, and hereby authorize the
Chairman of Board and County Clerk to issue County warrant
payable to the order of George & King Bridge Company
amt. of \$1103⁰⁰ payment in full for same, as per
appropriation.

The Board also reported that they
had examined and accepted the two wood truss
Pile Bridges in Frank Twp. as constructed by
the Wrought Iron Bridge Company of Canton Ohio.
As per contract with J. H. Morgan. Trustee of
said township.
