The aforesaid petition of Jas Baker as recorded in C.R.S. page 267. being under consideration the following action thereon was had by the Board of County Commissioners. to-wit:!

upon due consideration no legal objections having been offered against the establishment of said road hereinafter mentioned, and believing the same to be of public utility it is "Ordered" that the viewers report of view, and report and plat of survey be adopted, as follows.

Beginning at a point 0.18 Chains south of center of Sec 14. Twp 15. Range 18. Thence S 82° East 40 Chains to intersect east line of section. Thence East 0.00 Ch to angle stake. Thence South 40 Chains parallel to east line of section to intersect county line. And that said road be declared located and established as a public highway in accordance therewith. Full record thereof to be made in County Road Record and plat as Road No. And the Trustee of Marion township be notified to cause the same to be opened for the public travel 30 feet wide.
