Road Petitioned for by
M. Gale and 18 others }

On the 30th day of June 1891 a road petition signed by M. Gale and 18 others was filed and this day presented to the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County Kansas praying for the Location of a certain road, described as follows, to wit,

Beginning at N.E. Cor of Sec 35.
T14. R19. Thence S 60 R. W 160 R. N about 50 R to intersect road No 160.

Said petition was accompanied with a bond as required by law, signed by M. Gale as Principal and D. F. Heaston and A. M. Jardon as sureties in the sum of all expenses and costs accruing on said view.

Whereupon said bond was approved by the Board, and in appearing to the satisfaction of the Board that the law had been substantially complied with, it was ordered that Geo. F. Haas, E. W. Flora and Dr J. Holloway be appointed viewers on the proposed road, and that they meet in conjunction with the County Surveyor at the place of beginning, on the day designated in their notice and proceed to view and lay out said road according to law, giving to all parties a hearing and make due report of their proceedings to the County Board.

On the 10th day of June 1891 a road petition signed by W. Postma and 16 others, was filed and this day presented to the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County Kansas, praying for the Vacation and Location of certain roads, described as follows, to wit:

Beginning 80 R. S of N.E. Cor of Sec 9. T14. R18. running Thence S 80 R. W 80 R. and "Locate."

Beginning 80 R. S of N.E.

Cor. of Sec 9. T14. R18. Thence running due west 80 rods N² 60 R. to S line of Sec. 9.

Said petition was accompanied with a bond as required by law signed by W. Postma as principal and C. P. Møller and B. L. Hoover as sureties in the sum of all expenses
