Road Petitioned for by
Haron Miller et al. }

On the 10th day of July 1891. a road petitioned for by Haron Miller and 30. others was filed and this day presented to the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County Kansas. Praying for the "Location" of a certain road described as follows to wit:

Beginning at the NE Cor of NE 1/4 of Sec 5, T14 R19. Thence due N on N line of Sections 5 and 6, T14, R19, a distance 1 1/4 miles until same intersects road on N line of NE 1/4 Sec 6, T14 R19.

Thence Begin in center of County Road N 220. where said road leaves Sec line on each side of Sec 31, T13, R19. Thence S on Sec line to center of road above prayed for, and Tacate. That part of old road not on section line.

Said petition was accompanied with a bond as required by law, signed by Haron Miller as principal and J. M. Mory as surety in the sum of all expenses and costs accruing on said view.
