Road In the matter of a
Road Petitioned for by. }
Albert Haase et al.

On the 18th day of Feby. 1891. a road petition signed by Albert Haase and 21 others was filed and this day presented to the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County Kansas. praying for the relocation of a certain road described as follows, to wit:

Beginning at a point about 40 R. N. of when said road crosses Rock Creek. Thence in a westerly direction from said line around the bluff for a distance of about 15 or 20 rods. Thence in an easterly direction to intersect said road No 33 Marion Dr.

Said petition was accompanied with a bond as required by law, signed by Albert Haase as principal. in the sum of all expenses and costs accruing on said view. Whereupon said bond was approved by the Board, and it appearing to the satisfaction of the Board that the law had been substantially complied with. It was ordered that A. S. Baldwin, Wm. Hicks and Peter Mangers be appointed viewers on the proposed road, and that they meet in conjunction with the County Surveyor at the place of beginning, on the day designated in their notice and proceed to view and layout said road according to law giving to all parties a hearing, and make due report of their proceedings to the County Board.
