The Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County Kansas met at the office of the County Clerk

All of the members & the County Clerk being present. Pursuant to adjournment.

Auditing. The Board completed the Auditing of claims against the Co. Lease.
Douglas County Bank.

Mr R. W. Sparr Pres^d of said bank surrendered the unexpired lease for 3 rooms on 2nd floor of said bank, and asked that a new one be executed in lieu thereof for such rooms as would suit Co Commis^s.

The Board executed new lease for the term of one year from July 1st 1891. at \$15⁰⁰ per mo. for the one room on 2nd floor of said bank building, same as now used. and occupied by the Hon. Probate Court.

Appropriation! The Board appropriated a sum sufficient to pay all claims as audited and allowed by them at this July 1891. session, as shown on County Commis^s. Record of Allowances No 2, pages 11 to 22. Incl^d

Bridge Appropriated the sum of \$300⁰⁰ or so much thereof as is necessary to pay for the rebuilding of a County Bridge across Coal Creek about 1 1/2 miles N.E. of Tinsland Palmyra Twp.

Soldiers Burial of. Chairman and County Clerk authorized to issue County Warrant for same when ascertained by the Board.

Appointments The Board designated H. G. Hornold City Clerk, as a proper person to cause to be decently interred, the body of any Honorably discharged ex-military soldier, sailor, or marine, as provided by Ch. 184. Laws of 1885.
