Douglas County Bank.

Mr R. W. Sparrow Pres^d of said bank surrendered the unexpired lease for 3 rooms on 2nd floor of said bank, and asked that a new one be executed in lieu thereof for such rooms as would suit Co Comm^{rs}.

The Board executed new lease for the term of one year from July 1st 1891. at \$15⁰⁰ per mo. for the two rooms on 2nd floor of said bank building, same as now used and occupied by the Hon. Probate Court.

The Board appropriated a sum sufficient to pay all claims as audited and allowed by them at this July 1891 session, as shown on County Comm^{rs}. Record of allowances No 2. pages 11 to 22. incl

(Bridge) Appropriated the sum of \$300⁰⁰ or so much thereof as is necessary to pay for the rebuilding of a County bridge across Coal Creek about 1 1/2 miles S.E. of Finland Palmyra Dist.
