The Board of County Commissioners of Douglas Co. Kansas
met in special session at the office of the County Clerk
There were present

Bridge or
Arch Culvert }

The Board having under consideration the
proposition for the rebuilding of a bridge over
middle Toy Creek near the center of Sec 7, T15, R20.
Palmyra township, the following action thereon was had.
To wit:

After due consideration it was deemed best to
replace said bridge with an Arch Culvert, the same
to be 16 ft. Roadway. 24 ft. opening. 8 ft. on each side
of said opening, making a total length of 40 ft.
about 18 ft. high, with limestone foundation to turn
of arch. "Supposed to be about 5,000 ft. of masonry @ 12.^c
per ft."

To be constructed in a workman like manner.
said amount to be paid when work is accepted by the
Board of County Commissioners,

Provided that said
amount to be paid to the Contractor Mr George Miller
shall not exceed \$600.⁰⁰

An motion adjourned.
