The Board of County Commissioners of Douglas Co. Kansas met at the office of the County Clerk pursuant to adj^o All of the members and County Clerk being present.

Road Petition of J. D. Barton et al. }

In the matter of the aforesaid road petition and bond, praying for the "Location" and "Dedicating" a certain road in said county, as per petition signed by J. D. Barton and 15 others.

Also an additional petition signed by P. A. Dolbee and 11 others. said petitions being filed June 17th 1891.

And "Dedication" of road filed July 15th 1891. the following action thereon was had by the Board.

Dedication!

Clinton Kansas July 13th A.D. 1891.

For the consideration of (\$80.00) Eighty dollars We the undersigned land owners do hereby dedicate to the County of Douglas, State of Kansas, for a public highway, a strip of land described as follows.

Beginning at the center of Sec. 36. T13. R18. running thence East on said line a width of 40 feet a distance of 65 rods. Thence on south side of said line a width of 35 feet a distance of 95 rods. Thence East on North side of center line of Sec. 31. T13. R19. a width of 35 feet to center of said Section. Thence East on south side of center line of said Sec. 31. a width of 40 feet a distance of 120 Rods. Thence East on said line 15 rods. Thence in a North Easterly direction a distance of 25 rods to a point 6 1/2 rods North of the East center corner of said section connecting with the public highway.
