The Board completed the official canvass of the election returns of Nov 3rd 1891.

The following is the determination of the Board.
That L. N. Hindman was duly elected Sheriff of Douglas County
That A. L. Cox was duly elected Treasurer of Douglas County
That D. D. Brooks was duly elected County Clerk of Douglas County
That Levi Horner was duly elected Coroner of Douglas County
That James Brooks was duly elected Register of Deeds of Douglas Co.
That Holland Wheeler was duly elected Surveyor of Douglas County
That B. J. Hoskinson was duly elected Commissioner of Douglas County

There being a tie in the votes of the road owner in Dist No. 3. Eudora Township, the Board decided the same by lot, as the law directs. giving it to Mr Hagerman. Also tie in Dist No. 4 Wakarusa township, decided in favor of Mr Martin and in Dist No. 12, same Twp. in favor of Mr Myers.
