

Lawrence Kansas Jan. 7th A.D. 1892.

The Board of County Commissioners of Douglas Co. Kas.
met at the office of the County Clerk Bureau to adj.
All of the members and the County Clerk being present.

construction of a free wagon bridge across the
Kansas River at, or near the North Line of the City of
Eudora in said County.
