

Lawrence, Kansas. January 8th 1892.

The Board of County Commissioners met in regular session at the office of the County Clerk.

There were present Commissioners Walter, H. B. Adler and J. C. Moore, and the County Clerk.

Read

In the matter of a Road
petitioned for by
Chas. Pella et al. } Com. Book F page 356.

Mr. C. Pella petitioner, and others interested in said road being present were duly sworn by the County Clerk, and given a hearing. Without definite action the Board took same under advisement.

Board Approves.

The official bond of L. W. Hindman, Sheriff elect was examined and approved.

Read.

In the matter of a Road petitioned for by M. Gale et al. Upon due consideration, no legal objections having been offered against the establishment of said road hereinafter mentioned, and believing the same to be of public utility, it is ordered that the viewers report of view and report of plat and survey be adopted, as follows: Beginning at the NW corner of the NW 35th Town lot, Range 19, South about 1005 feet S 8° 35' E, thence West 81° 15' W 2650 feet, thence N. 75° 30' W 1800 feet, thence N. 76° W 200 feet to intersect road No. 160.

And that said road be declared located and established as a public highway in accordance therewith. Full record to be made in the County Road Record and plat as Road No. 474 and the Trustee of Willow Springs Township be notified to cause the same to be opened for the public travel 50 feet wide.

On Motion the Board adjourned to January 9th 1892.
