

Lawrence, Kansas. January 12th 1892 678

Vacate

Commencing at the County line between Douglas and Johnson Counties just south of the right of way of the A.T. & S.F. RR. running in a westerly direction and parallel to the A.T. & S.F. RR. about 3915 feet to the point where the above road intersects the road as located and surveyed.

And that said road be declared located and established as a public highway in accordance therewith.

Also that the above vacation be declared granted.

Full record thereof to be made in the County Road Record and Placed as Road No. 476 and the Trustee of Endora Township be instructed to cause the same to be opened for public travel. 40 feet wide.

Damages awarded: H.W. Meyer \$50⁰⁰

Tax Petition of

W.S. Foster

Praying to be allowed to redeem Lot 26 Media from the County Tax Sale of 1888 & subsequent endorsements, upon payment of \$1⁰⁰. It appearing that said lot had been erroneously assessed at \$175⁰⁰ instead of \$5⁰⁰ as it should have been, the prayer of the petitioner was granted.

Appropriation

The Board appropriated the sum of \$3,000⁰⁰ for the purpose of building a bridge across Wafarnoa river, either at Patton's or Barber's crossing. Place to be decided at a later period. By General inspection by the Board of Co. Commrs.

On Motion the Board adjourned to Jan'y 13th 1892.
