

Lawrence, Kansas. January 13th 1892.

The Board met pursuant to adjournment. Present Commissioners J.C. Moors, Chairman. H.B. Adler ^{and} B.F. Holbrook, ^{and} County Clerk F.D. Brooks.

Appropriations

The Board appropriated the sum of \$200⁰⁰ or so much of it as may be necessary, to pay for building an abutment to bridge at Robinson crossing over Mud Creek in Grant Township, and repair abutment ~~at~~ Mud Creek bridge over Lawrence ^{and} Lawrence wagon road, in Grant Township. The Board also appropriated whatever ^{sum} may be necessary to build walls at Eben Baldwin bridge over Mud Creek in Delaware Tp. not to exceed \$100⁰⁰.

Also:

Appropriated out of the County General Fund a sum sufficient to pay all claims as allowed by them at this Jan'y 1892 session, as shown by the County Commissioners' "Record of Claims Allowed" No. 3, from pages 30 to 44 inclusive.

Treasury Examiners

The Board appointed E.W. Wood of Lawrence, ^{and} G. L. Hill of Grant Township, to assist the Probate Judge as Treasury Examiners.
