The Board met in special session. Present: Commissioners J.C. Moore, Chairman and H.B. Adair, and the County Clerk.

Sup't of Poor Farm

The Commissioners appointed D. Still, Superintendent of the Poor Farm, for one year, commencing March 1/92, at a salary of \$350⁰⁰ from that date.

Remittance of Fine
against D. Dauserman

A Petition asking for the remittance of a fine of \$100⁰⁰ against D. Dauserman, sentenced for violating the Prohibitory Law to 30 days in County Jail and said fine of \$100⁰⁰. It being shown that said Dauserman had been confined in the Jail for 72 days, had paid the costs in the case, and was unable to pay said fine, the petition was granted and fine ordered remitted.

Release of Henry Steele

The Board ordered that Mr. Henry Steele, a colored boy who was sentenced to the County Jail for 30 days for some trivial offense, and who has been confined there for 90 days and is unable to pay the costs amounting to \$5⁰⁰, be released from custody.

Bank Approval

The Bond of D. Still, Sup't of Poor Farm, with J. Neal and J. Hessel as sureties was presented and approved.
Amount of Bond \$2,000⁰⁰
