The Board met in special session. Present, Commissioners J.C. Moore, chairman, H.B. Baker & B. F. Haskins, and the County Clerk.

Bids

The Board met for the purpose of receiving bids on bridges to be built at Patten's crossing over Wolfman creek in Lawrence Co. as per advertisement.

The hour of 12 o'clock noon. Having arrived the Board proceeded to open the bids, the following bids were received:

The bids as above being considered too high, they were all rejected by the Board, and the parties bidding were instructed to prepare plans for a bridge with 110 foot span, 14' roadway in the clear, 20 foot approaches, and present plans & bids in same at 5 o'clock P.M.

Patten of Addison Murphy.

A petition signed by 101 residents of Douglas County asking for a remittance of the fine of \$100⁰⁰ against Addison Murphy for a violation of the Prohibitory law, was presented to the Board. On motion the petition was granted, and an order issued to the Sheriff of Douglas Co. to release said Murphy from imprisonment upon the payment by him of all costs in said case.

The hour of 5 o'clock having arrived the Board proceeded to open the bids for bridge - as follows:
