The Board met pursuant to adjournment. Present, Commissioners J. C. Moore, chairman, H. B. Asher and B. F. Haskins, and the County Clerk.

Patton Bridge

The Board having under consideration the bids for building the bridge at the Patton crossing, in conjunction with the County Engineer, Holland Wheeler examined the plans submitted, and it appearing that the Mc. Kelly Bridge & Dam Works of Lawrence, Mass. had made the lowest and best bid, the contract for constructing same was awarded them for the sum of \$2,247.⁰⁰ to be paid on completion of same June 1st 1892. (as per contract on file) and upon its ^{approval and} acceptance by the Board and the County Engineer. Bridge to be built as per plans and specifications furnished by said Company on file in this office.

Stone Yard for Prisoners

The Board authorized the establishment of a stone yard, in which to have the prisoners who refused or were unable to work out their fine or costs, make macadam, providing arrangements can be made with the City Council of Lawrence for the purchase by them of said macadam.
