Road Section C.P.M. (Combeport T. page 356)

The road petition of C.P.M. & others was again called up and after giving the principal petitioners and others a hearing, it was laid over until Thursday, April 14th at 11 A.M.

Claims allowed

The Board examined and allowed various claims against the County.

Dedication of Road No. 224.

Lawrence, Kansas, April 7th 1892

For the consideration of the benefit which will be derived from the opening of Road No. 224 established July 15, 1870. We the undersigned do hereby dedicate to the County of Douglas for a public highway that portion of said road running through the N.E. $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec 14, and the N.E. $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec 11, all in Township 13. S. Range 20 E. described as follows: Begin at stake on the E boundary of said Sec 14, 76^{ft} do N of the N.E. corner of said sec, thence N 65 $\frac{1}{2}$ ° W 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ ° do N 23 $\frac{1}{2}$ ° E 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ ° do N 45 $\frac{1}{2}$ ° E 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ ° do. to a stake in E line of said section 11, said road to be a width of 50 feet.
