Road

The aforesaid petition of C. P. Pilla as recorded in C. R. 7th page 356, being under consideration, the following action thereon was had by the Board, to wit:

Upon due consideration no legal objections having been offered against the establishment of said road herein after mentioned and believing the same to be of public utility it is ordered: that the viewers report of view, and report and plat of survey be adopted as follows: Commencing 80 rods West of the NE corner of the NE¹/₄ of Section 15, Township 13, Range 21, thence due South 1320 feet, thence East 580 feet, thence S 31° 15' E 131 feet, thence S 25° 25' E 169 feet, thence S 41° 45' E 188 feet, thence S 31° E 148 feet, thence S 54° 45' E about 245' to center of County line road which bears S 42° 45' E, and that said road be declared located and established as a public highway in accordance therewith, full record to be made in the County Road Record and Plat as Road No. 478 and the Trustee of Andover Township be notified to cause the same to be opened for the public travel 40 feet wide. On the 25th day of March 1892, a Road Petition signed by Lewis Liewall and 30 others was filed, and on this day was presented to the Board of County Commissioners praying for the location of a certain road described as follows: Beginning at the NW corner of the NE¹/₄ of the NE¹/₄ of Sec 16, T 13, R 21, thence South along the quarter section line 80 R. ds. to the SW corner of said NE¹/₄ of NE¹/₄ Section 16, T 13, R 21.

Said petition was accompanied with a Bond as required by law signed by Lewis Liewall as Principal and Frank Blechl & 2nd as sureties in the sum of all costs and expenses accruing on said view. Whereupon said Bond was approved by the Board, and it appearing that the law had been complied with, it was ordered: that John O. H. A. C. Walker and J. P. Kendall be appointed Viewers on the proposed road, and that they meet in conjunction with the County Surveyor at the place of beginning on the day designated in this notice, and proceed to view and locate said road according to law, giving to all parties a hearing
