The aforesaid petition of J.P. Bolton as recorded in C.R.F. page 227, being under consideration, the following action was taken by the Board.

Upon due consideration, no legal objections having been offered against the establishment of said road hereinafter mentioned, and believing the same to be of public utility, it is ordered that the viewers report of view and report and plat of survey be adopted, as follows:

Beginning at the NE corner of the NW<sup>1/4</sup> Sec No. 27, Township 16, Range 20, thence running due West Var. 9° to NW corner of the NW<sup>1/4</sup> of Sec 27, T. 16, R. 20, being 40 feet wide and 2646 feet long, and that said road be located and established as a public highway in accordance therewith. All record thereof to be made in the County Road Record and Plat as Road No. 480 and the Trustee of Salina Township be notified to cause the same to be opened for public travel.

Road Petition of Dr. J. Steele et al.

The Board having under consideration the following road petition, to-wit: We the undersigned Landholders of Douglas County respectfully ask and petition that you cause to be viewed and located a road 40 feet wide in said County, as follows: Beginning at the 1/4 sec cor between sections 18 & 19, Twp 13, R 15 E, thence South Westerly 59 feet to a point 20 feet West of 1/4 section line thence South 20 feet West and parallel with the East boundary of the NW<sup>1/4</sup> of Sec 19-13-15, 2646 feet to the intersection with County road No. 480, with the following dedication attached:

"Dedication"

"For the sum of \$85<sup>00</sup> we the undersigned land owners do hereby dedicate to the County of Douglas, State of Kansas, for a public highway, the strip of land described in the above petition" (Signed) J.C. Moore, et al. J. T. Steele.

Whereupon the Board accepted the aforesaid Dedication in the name of the County, and ordered the same to be placed upon the Road Record of said County. Damages awarded Dr. J. Steele \$85<sup>00</sup>
