Appropriations

Rock Creek Bridge

Comm^r Moore introduced the following resolution: "Resolved that there be an appropriation of '\$2,000' or so much thereof as may be necessary for the purpose of building a bridge across Rock Creek at what is known as the George Washington crossing in Clinton Township, Douglas Co. Kan." on motion the resolution was adopted.

Deidman Crossing Bridge

Comm^r Haslinson introduced the following resolution: "Resolved that there be an appropriation of '\$2,000' or so much thereof as may be necessary from the General fund to build a County bridge at what is known as the Deidman crossing, on the Wallowa creek in Clinton Township, Douglas Co. Kan." On motion the resolution was adopted.

Barber Crossing Bridge

Comm^r Asher introduced the following resolution: "Resolved that there be an appropriation of Twenty five Hundred dollars or so much thereof as may be necessary for the purpose of erecting a wagon bridge over the Wallowa river at what is known as the Barber crossing in Clinton Township, Douglas Co. Kan." Comm^r Asher moved the adoption of the resolution, but not receiving a second, it was laid on the table.

Appropriation to Pay Bills.

The Board then appropriated sufficient money from the General fund to pay the bills allowed at the present session of the Board amounting to \$11,971.⁵⁰, see Record of Allowance of claims.
