Bridge Matters:

The Board authorized the County Clerk to advertise for
 proposals for the building of the following bridges: Bids to be opened
 at 12 o'clock noon on June 13th 1892. with the right to reject any or all
 bids.

One iron bridge across the Wakarusa river at a point near
 the Dickman crossing in Eureka Township near the N.E. cor of Sec 14.
 T33. R 20. One span 110 feet in length, 14 foot roadway, in the clear.

One bridge either wood or iron across Rock Creek at what is
 known as Dr. Washington crossing in Clinton Township. one span
 70 feet in length and 14 foot roadway in the clear.

Bidders to furnish plans and specifications.
