

Lawrence, Kans. June 9th 1892.

The Board of Equalization met pursuant to adjournment.

Present: J. C. Moore, chairman.

H. B. Adler and B. F. Hoskinson, and the County Clerk, F. O. Brooks.

The following changes were made in assessments in Fairbairn Tp.

NS^o 23-12-17 changed from 500⁰⁰ to 750⁰⁰

NS^o 31-12-17 " 1,150⁰⁰ " 1,000⁰⁰

The above changes were made upon the recommendation of James Dopping, the assessor of said Township.

The Board then adjourned as a Board of Equalization and came back as a Board of County Commissioners in special session.

Bridge Contracts.

The Board took under consideration the various bids received June 3rd 1892 for building the bridges at the Dietzman and Gr. Wash^g crossings, and it appearing that the Geo. E. King Bridge Company had made the lowest and best bids the contracts were awarded them as follows: Dietzman crossing over Wakarusa Cr. in Endora Tp. iron bridge, 110 feet span, 14 feet road-way in the clear at \$2,100. Washington crossing over Rock creek in Clinton Tp. iron bridge 70 feet span 14 feet road-way in the clear = \$1,000.

The Board having examined the site at the Washington crossing, decided to substitute iron tubes for the superstructure instead of piling, at a cost of \$200 in addition to the contract price of \$1,000.

The plans and specifications on file. Both bridges to be completed by October 1st 1892, and to be paid for upon their acceptance by the Board.

Petition for Release of
Tom Johnson.

A petition was presented to the Board asking for the release of one Tom Johnson from the County Jail, and it appearing that he had served his jail sentence in full, it was ordered that he be released upon payment of all costs in said case.

On motion the Board adjourned to June 10, 1892.
