

Lawrence, Kansas. June 10th 1892.

The Board of Equalization met pursuant to adjournment.
 Present: J.C. Moore, chairman.
 H.B. Baker & B. F. Hickman, and the County Clerk T.O. Brooks.
 It being the day set to hear complaints from Grant T.O.
 and no person appearing from that township the Board ad-
 journed as a Board of Equalization and convened as a
 Board of County Commissioners in special session.

Cancellation of Tax Sale:

It being shown that the W 25th of Twp 9, 10, 11 & 12
 Block 99 Ending, had been assessed as personal property by
 the Rail Road Assessors to the A.T. & S.F. R.R. Co. for the years
 1882 & 1883, and that the taxes had been paid by said R.R. Co.
 for said years. It was therefore ordered that the tax sales
 on said property for said years be cancelled upon the sale records
 of the County. The said lots having been assessed as R. Estate &
 sold to Douglas County as delinquent for those years.

On motion the Board adjourned to June 11th 1892.
