

Lawrence, Kansas, June 13th 1892.

The Board of Equalization met pursuant to adjournment.
Present: J. C. Moore, Chairman.
H. B. Fisher and B. F. Hoskinson, and the County Clerk, F. J. Brooks.

The following changes were made in the assessments of Clinton Township:

It being shown that 35 head of cattle assessed to J. A. Darnell which were alive on the 1st of March, were dead at the date of assessment, and it being customary in such cases to make no assessment, it was ordered that they be deducted from same, and the valuation changed from \$386.⁰⁰ to \$166.⁰⁰.

On the Fire Property of A. Owen, a deduction of \$700.⁰⁰ (as credits) was made, making the amount subject to taxation \$40.⁰⁰ instead of \$740.⁰⁰.

Land of Louisa Gates in Sec 24-13-18 changed from \$325.⁰⁰ to \$275.⁰⁰
In Main Township the assessment on R. W. Sec 13-14-18, was changed from \$1500.⁰⁰ to \$1400.⁰⁰

On motion the Board adjourned to June 14th 1892.
