Road

In the matter of a
Road petitioned for
J. H. Hines et al.

On the 6th day of July A.D. 1892, a road petition signed by J. H. Hines and 13 others was filed and this day presented to the Board praying for the vacation of a certain road described as follows:
"Commencing at the NW cor of Sec 7, T. 15. N. R. 18. thence South on section line between sections 7th and 18, T. 15. N. R. 18. and sections 12th and 13 T. 15. N. R. 17. to South line of Douglas County."

Said petition was accompanied by a bond as required by law signed by J. H. Hines as principal and Justice Howell as surety in the amount of all costs and expenses accruing on said view and vacation of said road in case the prayer of the petitioners be not granted. Whereupon said bond was approved by the Board and it appearing that the law had been substantially complied with, it was ordered that John P. Banker, W^m Messersheimer and Moses McMillan be appointed viewers on the proposed vacation, and that they meet in conjunction with the County Surveyor at the place of beginning on the day designated in their notice, and proceed to view the said proposed vacation, according to law giving to all parties a hearing and make due report of their proceedings to the County Board.

Road

In the matter of a

Abram Smith et al.

The aforesaid petition of Abram Smith et al. is recorded in Com^{rs} Record "F" pages 266-267. Being under consideration, the following action was taken by the Board.

Upon due consideration, no legal objections having been offered against the establishment of said road hereinafter described, and believing the same to be of public utility.

It is ordered that the viewers report of view and report and plat of survey be adopted as follows: Begin at the quarter section corner between sections 2 and 11 in Township 15, Range 18, thence N. 8° 50' East, East on line between sections 2 and 11, 4th chains to stake & stones N. 10° E, 1st chains to walnut tree 6" in dia. N 33° W 3rd chains stake & stones in E bank W fork of 8 mile creek runs L.S. N 56° 30' W 1st chains Elm tree 3" in dia N 77° W 1st chains stone in quarter section line 5th chains North of 1/4 corner the place of beginning. and vacate. Begin at 1/4 corner between sections 2 and 11
