Wood et al. for a ditch in Grant Township, Douglas Co. Kans.

And now on this the 5th day of July 1892 the petition
of said petitioners is presented to the Board for their action
thereon, and said Board of County Commissioners having con-
sidered the same, set the same down for a hearing on the
30th day of July 1892 at 2 O'Clock P.M. of said day and it is
ordered that one of said petitioners cause notice in writing
to be given to the owner of each tract of land sought to be affected
by these proceedings.
