The Board of County Commissioners of Douglas Co. Kans. met in the office of the County Clerk. pursuant to adjournment.

Present: J.C. Moore, chairman.

A.B. Adler and B.T. Robinson and the County Clerk. F.B. Brooks.

Read.

In the matter of a road
petitioned for by Lewis
et al.

The aforesaid petition of Lewis et al. as recorded in Comm^r Record "F" page 426. being under consideration, the following action thereon was taken by the Board, To-wit:

Upon due consideration, no legal objections having been offered against the establishment of said road hereinafter mentioned and believing the same to be of public utility, it is ordered, that the Engineer's report of view and report and plat of survey be adopted, as follows: "Begin at the North West corner of the North East quarter of section sixteen (16) Township Thirteen (13) N of Range Twenty one (21) East of 6th M. a stake, thence Var 8° 50' E. South on the subdivision line 20th chains to a stone." And that said road be declared located and established as a public highway in accordance therewith. Full record thereof to be made in the County Road Record and plat as Road No. and the Trustees of Andover Township be notified to cause the same to be opened for the public travel 40 feet wide, twenty feet on each side of the subdivision line.

Damages awarded. Herman Bladder \$50⁰⁰.
