Patten bridge in
Hannawa Tp.

The Board examined and accepted the Patten bridge in Hannawa Tp. and authorized the chairman of the Board and the County Clerk to issue scrip in payment of same, as per appropriation July 13th 1892.

Release of Harry Bruce
from jail.

A petition signed by J.R. Stanley et al. asking for the release of Harry Bruce from the County Jail, was presented to the Board, and it being shown that said Bruce was unable to pay the costs in his case, it was ordered that he be released from custody.

Bridge across Elk Creek
in Marion Tp.

The Board ordered the clerk to advertise for building wooden bridge across Elk creek at Harry White crossing in Marion Tp. according to plans and specifications on file in the County Clerk's office. Bids to be received on & up to Tuesday, Sept 20th at 12 o'clock P.M.
