

Lawrence, Kansas. Sept 10th. 1892.

The Board of County Commissioners met pursuant to adjournment in the office of the County Clerk.

Present: J.C. Moore, Chairman.
H.B. Asher and B.F. Hookinson, and the County Clerk, F.B. Brooks.

Grant Tp. Dist.

The County Engineer Holland Wheeler presented to the Board his report of the survey of the proposed ditch in Grant Township.

On motion the Board appointed Comm^r H.B. Asher as a committee to confer with the Mayor and Council of the City of Lawrence, for the purpose of obtaining permission to continue the proposed drain from Grant Tp. through North Lawrence, and also to ascertain what proportion of the expense towards putting in the same the City is willing to assume.

Release from Jail of {
W^m Porter

A petition signed by W^m Porter asking that he be released from further confinement in the County Jail, ^{and the remission of the fine of \$10⁰⁰} was presented to the Board. It appearing that said Porter had served the full time for which he had been sentenced, and that he had worked 54 days breaking rock for the County, and his pardon being recommended by the Sheriff, the Board ordered that he be released from custody.

In the matter of the Road petition of {
J.J. Bunce et al.

And now comes the principal petitioner herein, J.J. Bunce, and shows to the said Board of County Commissioners that the viewers heretofore appointed to view said proposed road and report thereon did not meet on the day designated by the said Board, nor on the following peculiar day; and therefore upon application of the said petitioner and the said Board being satisfied that the said viewers did so fail to meet, it is by said Board hereby

Ordered, that the said W^m Draper, Osgood Looman and M.B. Day heretofore appointed viewers herein, do meet at the place of beginning, ^{if ordered} in conjunction with the County Surveyor on the 3rd day of October A.D. 1892, and proceed to view and lay out said road according to law giving to all parties a hearing, and make due report of their proceedings to the County Board.

On motion the Board adjourned to Sept 19th 1892.
