The Board of County Commissioners met pursuant to adjournment in the office of the County Clerk.

The proposed petition of J.J. Bence et al as recorded in Comm^r's Record "F" page 451, being under consideration the following action was taken by the Board.

Upon due consideration, no legal objections having been offered against the establishment of said road, hereinafter described, and believing the same to be of public utility.

It is ordered, that the viewers report of view and report and plat of survey be adopted as follows: "Begin at the stone the center quarter section corner of section 36, T¹¹ S. R¹⁷ E. Var 8° 50' East. Thence N 22° W 1st chain to stake 25 feet West of Quarter sec line.

North parallel with and 25 feet from $\frac{1}{4}$ sec line 25th chain to a stake. N 18° 30' E parallel with and 25 feet from East side of road along West side of Block one ① of Town of Grover. 6th chain to stake 100 feet South of center of track A.T. & N.W. Ry. - a point in public road along right of way of Ry."

and that said road be declared located and established as a public highway in accordance therewith. Full record thereof to be made in the County Road Record and Plat as Road No. and the Trustee of Leamington Township be notified to cause the same to be opened for public travel 50 feet wide.
