Marvel and Jesse Humphreys be appointed viewers on the proposed road and that they meet in conjunction with the County Surveyor at the place of beginning, on the day designated in their notice, and proceed to view and lay out said road according to law, giving all parties a hearing, and make due report of their proceedings to the County Board.

The Board of J. W. Armstrong, Justice of the Peace in Eudora Tp. with W. L. Hill and J. W. Schabert as assessors, was presented to the Board, and on motion approved.

In the matter of a road
petitioned for by H. C. Swadley

The aforesaid petition of H. C. Swadley et al as recorded in Comm^t Record "F" page 312, being under consideration the following action was taken by the Board.

Upon due consideration, no legal objections having been offered against the establishment of said road as hereinbefore described, and believing the same to be of public utility.

It is ordered that the viewers report of view and report and plat of survey of a portion of said road be adopted as follows: Begin at the NW cor of the NW 1/4 Sec 1, T. 12 N. R. 18 E. thence East on N line of Section 1, a distance of 1/4 mile, and that said road be declared located and established as a public highway in accordance therewith. Full record thereof to be made in the County Road Record and Plat as Road No. and the Trustee of Kawaka Township be notified to cause the same to be opened for public travel 40 feet wide. Damages allowed: E. L. Laine 26⁰⁰. Ella J. Otter 30⁰⁰.
