Treasury Examiners

In the matter of a Petition
for release of James Hoyt
from Co Jail

A Petition signed by Mr. J. M. Foster and 104 others asking that James Hoyt be released from the County Jail was presented to the Board. Also the Sheriff and the Justice of the Peace before whom he was convicted recommended the release.

Whereupon it being shown that said Hoyt had served his full jail sentence, and had paid all costs in the case, and that he was unable to pay the fine imposed.

It was ordered that he be released from further custody.

Appropriations

The Board appropriated a sufficient sum out of the General Fund of Douglas County to pay all claims as allowed by them at this Oct session 1892. as shown the Comm^r's Record of Allowances N. S. pages 73 to 82 inclusive.

Elk Creek Bridge

The Board appropriated "\$75" or so much thereof as may be necessary to build bridges over Elk Creek in Marion Township at the Harry White crossing.

Appropriation
Approach to Anderson Bridge

The Board appropriated "\$50" Towards building the approach across the island to connect with the bridge across the Kansas river at Anderson. This appropriation is made with the understanding that the County Commissioners of Leavenworth Co. appropriate a like amount for the same purpose. as per agreement.
