Release of A. D. Dykes;
from C. Jail 3

A petition signed by James E. Brooks and others asking that A. D. Dykes now imprisoned in the County Jail, convicted of assault & battery, be released from custody, was presented to the Board and on motion granted.

petitioned for by C. Wicks et al }

On the 10th day of January 1893, a Road Petition signed by C. Wicks and 41 others was filed and this day presented to the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas Co. Kans. praying for the location and vacation of a certain road described as follows. To-wit:

Begin at the center of section 22 T. 13. R. 18. thence running due West about 200 rods to a fence, thence in a South Westerly direction about 70 rods to a fence, thence due West along said fence to West line of Sec 21, T. 13. R. 18. thence due South to intersect 2nd Empire State Road.

'Traverse'

Commencing about 80 rods S. of NW^{1/4} of NE^{1/4} Sec. 20, T. 13. R. 18. thence running in a North Easterly direction to intersection of road running South on section line between sections 21 and 22 T. 13. R. 18.

Said petition was accompanied by a bond as required by law signed by Loren Wicks as Principal and A. L. Baldwin and C. Wicks as sureties in the sum of all expenses and costs accruing in said road. Whereupon said bond was approved by the Board and it was appearing that the law had been substantially complied with, it was ordered that W^m Draper, John Badely and R. T. Richards be appointed Viewers on the proposed road, and that they meet in conjunction with the Surveyor at the place of beginning on the day designated in their notice, and proceed to view and lay out said road according to law giving to all parties a hearing and make due report of their proceedings to the County Board.
