County Bonds }

The Board met for the purpose of making arrangements for the investment of the Douglas County Sinking Fund in Lawrence City Bonds. Without action the matter was laid over for further consideration.

The Board authorized the County Treasurer to pay Douglas Co Bonds due in 1906, to the amount of \$4,000 @ 108 $\frac{1}{2}$ together with accrued interest, out of any money in hand belonging to the Douglas Co Sinking Fund.

On motion the Board adjourned to March 1st 1893.
