The Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County met in special session in the office of the County Clerk

B. F. Hoskinson and M. A. Winter and the County Clerk.

Exchange of Lawrence
City Bonds

The Board authorized the County Treasurer to pay out of the Douglas County Sinking Fund the amount of \$1500. as exchange on the following Lawrence City Bonds owned by Douglas County: No. 1, 2, 19 and 45 = 2,000. Exchange = 600.00
Douglas Co Bonds No. 123, 124, 125, 126 = 4,000. " = 500.00
The Lawrence City Bonds No. 1 to 19 and No. 45 were purchased under order dated March 1, 1892 and were subject to call. The County Treasurer is hereby authorized to exchange said 6% Bonds for a like amount of bonds drawing 5%.

Purchase of chairs
for Court Room

The Board instructed Robertson Paris to furnish 100 chairs for the Court Room at an expense not to exceed \$110.00

Desk for Court Room

Comm^r Acker was authorized to purchase new desk for the use of the Judge of District Court.

Repairs at County Auditors

Comm^r Hoskinson was instructed to visit P. A. Dorbin & inspect repairs being made on buildings and report at regular session in April.

Completion of bridge
over Chicken Creek

P. A. Dorbin notified the Board that the bridge across Chicken Creek in Sec 7, T. 12. R. 19. was completed. On motion Comm^r Winter and the County Surveyor were instructed to examine said bridge and report at next meeting of the Board.
