Exchange of
Lawrence City Bonds }

The Board on motion ordered County Treasurer A.L. Co. to exchange Lawrence City Bonds Nos. 20, 34, 35 and 55 of \$1000 each bearing 6% belonging to the Douglas County Sinking Fund, for a like amount of refunding bonds of the City of Lawrence numbered respectively 21, 22, 23 and 24 drawing 5% interest and due Jan'y 1/1923.

The following is a copy of order issued to A.L. Co.:

A.L. Co. Treas^r Douglas Co. Kas.

Sir: Bonds Nos. 20, 34, 35 & 55 each calling for the sum of \$1000 and each of the City of Lawrence in the approved Augst and State, said bonds drawing 6% interest, are now held in the sinking fund of the County of Douglas.

And whereas, said bonds were and are subject to call from and after the 1st day of Jan'y 1893, and whereas the said bonds have been duly called by the said City of Lawrence,

you are now therefore hereby authorized by the Board of Commissioners in and for the said County of Douglas to exchange said bonds for a like amount of refunding bonds of the aforesaid City of Lawrence, which are duly numbered 21, 22, 23 & 24, the bonds last aforesaid mentioned being dated Jan'y 1/93 and bearing due Jan'y 1, 1923, drawing interest at the rate of five (5) per cent.
