Bridge Petition of
Pat Cummings, Leechfork Tp. }

The petition of Pat Cummings et al for bridges over East Fork of Com Creek in Sec 15, T. 12, R. 18, in Leechfork Tp. was heard by the Board, and after hearing all evidence in the case the following resolution was introduced by Commissioner Winter and on motion adopted. Resolved that there be an appropriation of the sum of three hundred and fifty Dollars (\$350) or such a part of it as is necessary from the General Fund of said Douglas County to build a wagon bridge over the East fork of Com Creek in Leechfork Township on the half section line at center of section 15, T. 12, Range 18.

In the matter of a road
petitioned for by C. Wicks et al }

The aforesaid petition of C. Wicks et al as recorded in Commissioners Record "F" page 505 being under consideration, the following action thereon was had by the Board of County Commissioners to-wit: Upon due consideration no legal objections having been offered against the establishment of said road hereinafter mentioned and believing the same to be of public utility it is ordered, that the viewers report of view and report and plat of survey be adopted, as follows. To-wit: Beginning at the center of section 22, T. 13, R. 18, thence running due West about 20 rods to a fence, thence in a South westerly direction about 70 rods to a fence, thence due West along said fence to West line of R. 18, section 21, T. 13, R. 18, thence due South to intersect Leechfork State road, said road to be forty feet in width, and that said road be declared located and established as a public highway in accordance herewith. Full record thereof to be made in the County Road Record and plat as Road No. and the Trustee of Clinton Township be notified to cause the same to be opened for the public travel as far wide

Appointment of

The Board re-appointed Dr. E.D. Phillips as County Physician on same terms as in previous years except as to visits to the County Asylum, for which he will be allowed \$1⁷⁵ per visit. See contract April 15th 1890. Record "F" page "234".
