Health Officer }

D. Linnane who was appointed County Health Officer on Sept 19/92 by the Board, having failed to qualify and refusing to qualify, the Board this day appointed Dr. W. J. Gomer as such officer.

Bridge Petition of }
H. B. Rogers }

The Board had up the petition of H. B. Rogers et al for bridge across Oakley creek in Leecompton Tp. after full hearing Comm^r Holliman moved that further consideration of same be deferred until the July session, which motion prevailed.

Official County }
Paper }

In the matter of designating an official County paper Comm^r Winter moved to accept the bid of the Lawrence Grand Publishing Co as per their proposition. To wit: The Grand Publishing Company will do all the County printing at 1/2 the legal rate excepting the delinquent Tax lists and final tax notices, said lists and notices to be published at full legal rates excepting the heads, which have been heretofore allowed at ten dollars per head, our price for which will be five dollars per head. The motion received no second. Comm^r Asher then introduced the following resolution: "Resolved, that we hereby designate, make, constitute, create and appoint the Lawrence Journal the official paper of Douglas County for the term of one year, and this designation is made with the distinct understanding and agreement between said Journal Company and the Lawrence World and said Board, that the World shall bear one half of the expense and receive and have one-half the compensation of all the public printing of this County for the term of one year." which resolution was adopted by the following vote:
