in a North Westly direction to where it will intersect the section line between Section 22 and 23. 32 rods of said North of the South West corner of Section 23, in above town and range, thence North on said section line to the creek near the North line of North West $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 23, thence in a North Westly direction near the creek to the $\frac{1}{2}$ section line running East and West through Section 22, thence West on said $\frac{1}{2}$ section line to the $\frac{1}{2}$ sec line running North & South through Section 22 near Cold Creek School House.

Said Petition was accompanied with a bond as required by law signed by J. W. Counts as principal and J. W. Jenkins et al as sureties in the sum of all costs and expenses accruing on said view.

Whereupon said bond was approved by the Board, and it appearing to the satisfaction of the Board that the law had been substantially complied with. It was ordered, that John Barber, H. A. Oakes and J. H. Nichols be appointed Viewers on the proposed road, and that they meet in conjunction with the County Surveyor at the place of beginning on the day designated in their notice and proceed to view and lay out said road according to law giving to all parties a hearing and make due report of their proceedings to the County Board.

On the 12th day of April 1893, a Road Petition signed by W. A. Dean and 31 others was filed and this day presented to the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County Kansas, praying for the Location and Vacation of a certain road described as follows
To wit: Locate: Beginning at center of Sec 28, T 13, R 18, on N side of $\frac{1}{2}$ section line, thence East on N side of $\frac{1}{2}$ sec line 80 rods, thence South 40 feet to South side of $\frac{1}{2}$ sec line, thence East on South side of $\frac{1}{2}$ sec line 240 rods more or less to intersect with N & S road on $\frac{1}{2}$ sec line of Sec 27.
Vacate: Part of Road 172 as follows: Begin at NW cor of Sec 27, T 13, R 18, & L along W line of Sec 27, thence South across Rock Creek to intersect with Road 407 in NW corner of Sec 28." Said petition was accompanied with a bond as required by law signed by W. A. Dean as principal and R. L. Patten as surety in the sum of all expenses and costs accruing on said view. Whereupon said bond was approved by the Board, and it appearing to the satisfaction of the Board that the law had been substantially complied with. It was ordered that John Dobler, John Martin and Henry Ruffer be appointed Viewers on the proposed road, and that they meet in conjunction with the County Surveyor at the place of beginning, on the day designated in their notice and proceed to view and lay out said road according to law, giving to all parties a hearing and make due report of their proceedings to the County Board.
