White et al. as recorded in Commissioners Record, 7th page 506 being under consideration, the following action thereon was had by the Board of County Commissioners to wit: Upon due consideration no legal objections having been offered against the abandonment of said road hereinafter mentioned, and believing the same to be of public utility it is ordered, that the viewers report of view and report and point of survey be adopted, as follows: Tract, Begin at 1st chain West of N.E. corner of 28th of 24th of section 4 in Township 13, Range 21, thence run 9th East, North 1st chains to stake, East 1st chains to stake point 2nd the West 1st line, North parallel with 1st line, 32nd chains stake, East 5th chains stake on L. & L. land, North 1st chains stake, N 87th E 2nd chains stake, N 10th W 2nd chains stake, N 89th W 1st chains stake, N 62nd W 1st chains stake, S 62nd W 6th chains to old ferry, width of road 40 feet and that said road be declared vacated in accordance therewith, full record to be made thereof in the County Road Record.
