W. Sparr (1). The 2nd & 3rd ballots the same as 1st. 4th Ballot, J. C. Wallin (1), J. F. Thompson (1), G. Governor (1). 5th Ballot, G. Governor 2, J. C. Wallin 1.

Mr. Governor having received a majority of 5 the cast was declared elected, and on being notified of his election appeared and took the oath of office.

Chairman Elected. On motion the Board elected B. F. Holbrook as chairman.
