The Board of County Commissioners met pursuant to adjournment in the office of the County Clerk.

Treasury Examiners

The Board on motion appointed C. S. Finch and R. W. Spurr as Treasury Examiners for the ensuing quarter.

Appropriation to buy land adjoining Deer Farm

The Board on motion appropriated the sum of "675" for the purchase of the following described land adjoining the Deer Farm: "all that portion of the West 1/4 of NW 1/4 Sec 17, T. 23. R. 22. lying South of Wafarusa Creek, containing 15th acres more or less." The above land was purchased of Levi H. Cheez.

In the matter of a Road
petitioned for by G. C. Liger
and others

On the 14th day of June 1893 a Road Petition signed by G. C. Liger and 31 others was filed and the day presented to the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas, praying for the location of a certain road described as follows, to wit: "Beginning at the N. W. East corner of N 1/4 of NW 1/4 of Section 36, Town 13, Range 17, thence running due South about 3/4 of a mile to intersect Lawrence & Emporia State road." Said petition was accompanied with a bond as required by law signed by G. C. Liger as principal and W. H. Patton and A. T. Strong as sureties in the sum of all expenses and costs accruing on said road.

Whereupon said bond was approved by the Board, and it appearing to the satisfaction of the Board that the law had been substantially complied with. It was ordered that Leroy Woodward, E. M. Hill, Jack W. Perry and be appointed Viewers on the proposed road, and that they meet in conjunction with the County Surveyor at the place of beginning, on the day designated in their notice and proceed to view and lay out said road according to law, giving to all parties a hearing and make due report of their proceedings to the County Board.
