

Lawrence, Kans., Oct 5th 1893.

The Board of County Commissioners met pursuant to adjournment in the office of the County Clerk.

Present: B. F. Hoskinson, Chairman.

In the matter of a Road
petitioned for by D. M. Mifflin et al }

The aforesaid petition of D. M. Mifflin et al as recorded in Commissioners Record F page 546, being under consideration, the following action thereon was had by the Board of County Commissioners To-wit: Upon due consideration no legal objections having been offered against the establishment of said road herein-after mentioned and believing the same to be of public utility it is ordered that the viewers report of view and report and plat of survey be adopted as follows: Begin at intersection of North-South road No 392 and East-West road No 266, between Secs 7 & 8 Township 14 Range 18. (Magnetic Variation $9^{\circ}30'$ East) thence first course South 67° East $6^{\frac{1}{2}}$ chains to angle stake
 " Second " South 20° East " " " " " "
 " Third " North $41^{\circ}30'$ East $3^{\frac{1}{2}}$ " " " " " "
 " Fourth " North $34^{\circ}30'$ East $2^{\frac{1}{2}}$ " " " " " " center of road No. 266 end of new road.

Also.

From the stake at the end of the second course, continue South 20° East the chains to angle stake. Thence 2nd course South $58^{\circ}45'$ West $3^{\frac{1}{2}}$ chains to center of road No 392, end of road.

Vacation

From the place of beginning at intersection of roads No 392 and 266 vacate to the termini of the two roads as above, and that said road be declared located and established as a public highway in accordance therewith.

Also that the above vacation be declared granted, full record to be made thereon in the County Road Record and that as roads No and the Trustees of Marion Township be notified to cause the same to be opened for the public travel, 60 feet wide

Compensation of Health Officer

The Board on motion fixed the compensation of W. J. Linnick County Health Officer at the rate of \$200 per year, this amount to include all traveling expenses incurred by him as such officer.

On motion the Board adjourned to Oct 6th 1893.
