

Lawrence, Kans. Oct 9th. 1893.

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The Board of County Commissioners met pursuant to adjournment in the office of the County Clerk.

In the matter of a road
petitioned for by A. J. Sheppard
and 20 others }

On the 4th day of October 1893 a Road Petition signed by A. J. Sheppard and 20 others was filed and this day presented to the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kans. praying for the widening of a certain road described as follows: "Beginning at the NW corner of Sec 8, Twp 15, Range 21, and running South $\frac{1}{2}$ mile, eight rods of said road at present not exceeding 20 feet in width."

Said petition was accompanied with a bond as required by law signed by A. J. Sheppard as principal and E. C. Waters, J. E. Gault and Emanuel Bixler as sureties in the sum of all expenses and costs accruing on said road. Whereupon said bond was approved by the Board and it appearing to the satisfaction of the Board that the law had been substantially complied with. It was ordered that P. Marvel, Fred Mulrow and Joseph Patterson be appointed viewers on the proposed road, and that they meet in conjunction with the County Surveyor at the place of beginning on the day designated in their notice and proceed to view said road according to law, giving to all parties a hearing and make due report of their proceedings to the County Board.
