Township 14 South of Range 20 East of the 6th P.M. Thence Var 8° 50' East. X 38° 30' W 13.00 chains to a stake 20 feet East of the West boundary of section 23 and 8th chains North of the NW corner of said section 23, thence N. 76° 10' E parallel with and 20 feet from the West boundary of section 23, 28.70 chains to a stake in the left bank of Coal Creek. Thence X 52° 30' S down stream along bank of Coal Creek 5.00 chains to a stake 20 feet South of North boundary of Sec 22 of Sec 22, thence West parallel with the N. 76° 10' E of Sec 22, 35.92 chains to a stake 20 feet South of the center quarter section corner in Sec 22, Twp 14, Range 20, E. and that said road be declared located and established as a public highway in accordance therewith, full record thereof to be made in the County Book Record and plat as road No. and the Trustee of Palmyra Township be notified to cause the same to be opened for the public travel 40 feet wide. Damages allowed D. Harshbarger = \$125⁰⁰ Julia E. Curston = \$60⁰⁰. The above petition was granted with the understanding that Mr Harshbarger be allowed to put culvert for cattle under the said road.
